SUPPORTING THE INTEGRATION OF UKRAINIAN REFUGEES IN ROMANIA AND HUNGARY



În the heart of communities that have welcomed people fleeing conflict—Brașov and Budapest—we offer integrated social and educational support services, skills development, and access to the labor market in Resilience Innovation Facilities (RIFs).

These spaces, created by the Terre des hommes Foundation, are becoming engines of social inclusion for refugees and their families.

Social services we offer in Brașov:



SOCIAL SUPPORT



translation services, access to medical and educational services or state benefits, food and non-food support

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AND SUPPORT FOR EDUCATION



After-school program for children aged 4-15

The After School Program supports parents while they are working or looking for a job, offering children educational and recreational activities in a safe and organised environment.

The activities focus on psychosocial support, not on school subjects. The program lasts 4 hours/day, in the afternoon.



Workshops on digital and technological skills within the RIF

With access to modern equipment (3D printers, laser and vinyl cutters, embroidery machines, heat presses, 3D scanners), participants can design, build, and collaborate in a practical and fun way, gaining confidence in their own abilities.



Soft skills – workshops for adults

The Soft Skills Program offers practical workshops for personal development and psychological and psychosocial support.

We want to support at least 100 people to ease their transition to a new country and find a job.

The workshops will address topics related to integration, socialization, and independent living, with a focus on education, career guidance, and employment.



Romanian language courses (until November 2025)

At least 100 people will participate in Romanian language courses and non-formal learning activities tailored to participants' needs, including conversation clubs, small group support sessions, and practical activities for those who have already taken courses but need more confidence in applying the language on a daily basis.



SUPPORT FOR INTEGRATION INTO THE LABOR MARKET:

Employment counseling

ADDJB professionals will conduct workshops in Romanian dedicated to developing the skills needed for employment: writing CVs and cover letters, preparing for interviews, understanding employee rights, and improving communication with employers, etc.

Participants will receive personalized counseling in identifying suitable job vacancies, understanding the labor market, and validating previously acquired skills and qualifications.
